"Not all heroes wear capes." That's true. Some wear Roman collars.

In 2021 the US Navy posthumously awarded Lt. Thomas M. Conway, a Catholic chaplain from the Diocese of Buffalo, the Navy Cross, the second highest honor bestowed for valor and extraordinary heroism.

Father Conway was one of the many casualties of WWII. He and most of the crew of the USS Indianapolis died at sea after their cruiser was torpedoed by a Japanese sub in 1945.

It staggers the mind when you consider the loss of life. Of the 1,196-crew, only 317 survived. If they were not immediately killed by the

initial blast, they died from dehydration, hunger, and shark attack as they desperately waited days in the Pacific for rescue.

Survivors recalled the bravery and pastoral zeal of Father Conway who swam among the frightened sailors, bringing them spiritual comfort and hope. He ultimately succumbed to the ocean's harsh conditions.

Sadly, it took 76 years for the US Navy to recognize his courage. A few factors prevented him from receiving the well-deserved honor.

At the ceremony in his native city of Waterbury, Connecticut, Secretary of the Navy Kenneth J. Braithwaite stated: "Today, we are here to right the record and send a message that we shall never forget. My mother taught me that it's never too late to say you're sorry. Today the Navy is sorry for not recognizing Chaplain Conway's heroism, dedication, and courage sooner."

My mother taught me to always say thank you.

Look around and in the mirror. See how blessed we are thanks to the countless men and women who like Father Conway made the ultimate sacrifice for our freedom.

"Greater love has no one than this: to lay down one's life for one's friends" (John13:13).

May we in turn show our gratitude by prayerfully remembering them this weekend and always thinking of them with profound love and respect.







# The Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ – Corpus Christi

The feast of the Body and Blood of Christ is celebrated in the USA on the Sunday after Trinity Sunday. Like Trinity Sunday, it does not recall an event in the life of the Lord Jesus but expresses one of the Church's long-held beliefs, in this case that Jesus lives on in the Holy Eucharist, the Most Blessed Sacrament.

While the somberness or solemnity of Holy Week mute the observance the gift of the Holy Eucharist on Holy Thursday, Corpus Christi Sunday augments our celebration of this gift at another point in the liturgical year.

The feast was first observed in France prior to the year 1200 and allowed for the faithful in festive celebrations to recall that Jesus Christ is really present, Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity, and with his people in the Holy Eucharist. Its processions were part of the spring celebrations in the life of the local religious communities or towns. To paraphrase the Old Testament, "How lucky are we! What God is like our God who is so close to His People" (Psalm 77).
