





# Gospel of Mark (and John 6)

It's been 10 Sundays since the priest (and deacon) wore green Mass vestments. The season of Ordinary Time returned after Pentecost and remains until the First Sunday of Advent, 4 Sundays before Christmas.

Ordinary Time allows the Church to take a break, so to speak, from the heightened awareness and intensity of the four major liturgical seasons: Advent-Christmas and Lent-Easter. During this period are most saints' celebrations and a special dedication to one of the Synoptic Gospels (Matthew, Mark, and Luke) each Sunday.

The readings we hear each Ordinary Time Sunday are based on a three-year cycle (A, B, C) with each year focused on one of the three gospels mentioned above. Presently we are in Year B, dedicated to Mark's Gospel. Each Sunday we hear a portion of Mark's Gospel, generally picking up where we left off the previous Sunday. Thus, over the three-cycle of Ordinary Time, we stand for, hear and acknowledge the three Synoptic Gospels.

You might be asking, "What about John?" John's Gospel is read every year during Easter Season and at special feasts throughout the year. Also, readings from John 6, Jesus's important discourse on the Holy Eucharist, are read on five Sundays of Ordinary Time during Year C, since Mark's Gospel, read during that year, is relatively short.

Remember, whatever the name given for the season when green is worn at Mass, there is nothing ordinary about our time with God each weekend!
