

"Heaven touches Brooklyn in July!"

This phrase coined by the parishioners of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel in Williamsburg captures the joy the parish experiences each July when it celebrates its beloved feast in honor of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel and St. Paulinus of Nola.

As a former pastor of Mt. Carmel, I highly encourage you to make a visit to "Da Feast." You may come home heavier but not disappointed.

The main highlight of the feast: The Dance of the Giglio. This 85 ft / 3+ ton structure is danced in the streets of Williamsburg by 100 men as an Italian band spurs them on.

This tradition, brought to America 137 years ago by immigrants from Nola, Italy, honors the patron saint of Nola, San Paolino or St. Paulinus. Legend tells us that as the bishop of Nola, San Paolino offered himself as a ransom for the only child of a widowed mother. After years of incarceration, he was rescued by a Turk who was moved by his heroic virtue. On his return to Nola, the townsfolk greeted him with swaying "gigli" or "lilies."

Dear Pastors and Administrators,

As you know we are coming up on the conclusion of this year's Deanery visits. Monsignor Joseph Grimaldi, your local Regional Episcopal Vicar and I have listened to your suggestions and concerns, and the conversations have personally been very encouraging to me.

As we look to the new pastoral year, I am committed to implement our Reconfiguration Process, with its three different stages throughout our diocese, in order to effectively utilize our financial and clergy personnel resources. The purpose of the Reconfiguration Process is to strengthen the relationship that already exists among parish communities in particular areas of our diocese and to enhance the varied ministries that each parish offers, while collaborating, partnering or merging with another parish.

Collaboration, partnerships, or parish mergers are taking place in many dioceses and a number of parishes share their pastor with at least one other parish with that number growing. The issues we face here in our diocese, though unique in their own ways, are similar to what is happening throughout the country. We are one family in faith.

With this in mind, pastors in each deanery have been tasked to discuss and adjust their Mass schedules in collaboration with the other parishes in their deanery this coming Fall. You are also strongly encouraged to work with neighboring parishes outside your assigned deanery, if pastorally necessary. To that effect, I am asking that no Mass intentions be taken after June 30, 2025. It is essential that every parish share in this commitment.

You will hear more about this process in the coming months, and you are encouraged to engage actively in the consultation opportunities at the deanery level. Please provide your thoughts and ideas to your Dean. This is an important moment for new opportunities in our diocese. It is crucial that this process be rooted in prayer and open to the guidance of the Holy Spirit. I ask that you be faithful to patient discernment and committed to creating a plan with your Parish Leadership, Dean and Regional Vicar that will set the roadmap for the future vitality and vibrancy of all our parishes in Brooklyn and Queens.

Thank you for your cooperation as we embark in this new phase of reconfiguration in our diocese. Be assured of my continued prayers for each of you and parish communities.

St. Mel's Office of Faith Formation oversees the St. Mel School of Religion Program which provides Religious Instruction to children in grades 1 through 8 who attend public schools.

Through our Religious Education program, we seek to increase children's awareness of the presence of God in their daily lives through Scripture, prayer and an age-appropriate curriculum. The program also prepares the children to complete their initiation into the Catholic Church through the Sacraments of Penance/First Communion and Confirmation.

Classes are held on Wednesdays from 3:30 pm to 5:00 pm for Grades 1-5 and from 6:30 pm to 8:00 pm for Grades 6-8.



Eucharistic Devotions -

Solidarity or Communion

Another facet of Eucharistic devotion is *solidarity*, or better said, *communion*. The goal of our devotion is to be better united to the Person of Jesus Christ whom the Church professes is present in the Holy Eucharist, "body and blood, soul and divinity."

First and foremost, spending time with the Lord allows for greater union. The custom of a *holy hour* grew out of the Lord's words from Holy Thursday night: "So you could not keep watch with me for one hour?" (Mt 26:40). Of course, any amount of time with the Lord is a blessing and benefit.

During a holy hour, alone or with others, there can be silent periods of adoration and contemplation, or particular prayers and litanies directed to Jesus present in the Blessed Sacrament. If these periods are community-oriented, then the Holy Eucharist is usually exposed in the monstrance for a visual experience and concluded with benediction (receiving a blessing with the Sacred Host).

First Friday Mass (as popularized by St. Margaret Mary Alacoque)—or better yet, daily Mass—and the devout reception of Holy Communion is a paramount means to draw closer to Jesus. Those unable to do so can make a spiritual Communion, opening the heart and soul to the presence and grace of Jesus who is truly present in the Holy Eucharist.
